Here is the research results of women not wanting to have the baby

"The reasons most frequently cited were that having a child would interfere with a woman's education, work or ability to care for dependents (74%); that she could not afford a baby now (73%); and that she did not want to be a single mother or was having relationship

problems (48%). Nearly four in 10 women said they had completed their childbearing, and almost one-third were not ready to have a child. Fewer than 1% said their parents' or partners' desire for them to have an abortion was the most important reason. Younger women often reported that they were unprepared for the transition to motherhood, while older women regularly cited their responsibility to dependents."

More than half of the abortions are because they didn't believe they could support the child or thought it would be a 'burden' on their work/school life. Not because it would hurt them physically. You know why these are the results? The Bible doesn't lie when God says He won't give us something we can't handle; everything happens for a reason. Again, we as Christians need to start being more open about the love and support God gives us in hope that more people have the correct view. Even in Isaiah 49:15 God tells us that even if the mother (notice how I said mother, not host) of the womb is to forget about her son (or daughter) that He has not in any way forgotten us.
